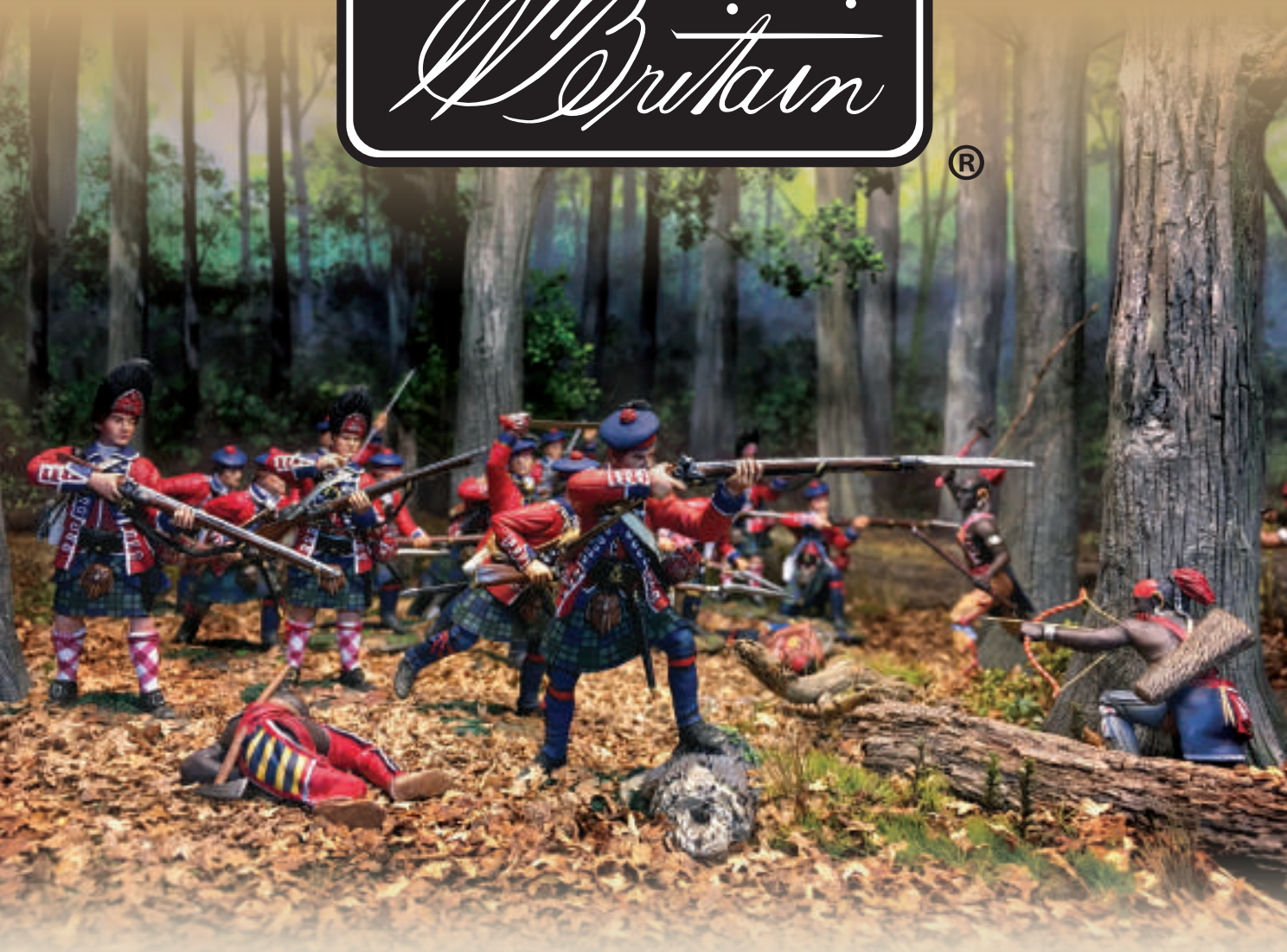

The glossy figures are a true 54mm figure and are painted in the classic style with simple, neat painting finished in a high gloss lacquer.

In Old Norse, the term Viking does not appear to be employed for any people or culture. However, in the ninth century the word “wicing” appeared in an Anglo Saxon poem *Widsith*, and the term generally referred to Scandinavian raiders.

In modern English this term has evolved into Viking, describing the Nordic seafaring people who explored, traded and raided from their Northern European homelands during the late eighth to the late eleventh centuries.

# CLASH of EMPIRES

The *Clash of Empires* collection is inspired by the events that took place on the frontiers of Colonial North America from the 1750s to the 1790s. Figures representing European soldiers, militias and Native American Warriors are continually added to this exciting range. This catalog includes four new infantry representing the 42nd Royal Highland Regiment, as they would have appeared in North America during the period 1759 to 1763. These new additions would be perfect additions to use with new *Art of War Bushy Run* sets that appeared in the Summer 2016 catalog.

Finally, we have also re-mastered our Commander-in-Chief's Guard (Washington) 1777 to 1783. There are several conflicting accounts of the dress of this unit, and it is thought that, like much of the rest of the Continental Army, it varied between new clothing issues.

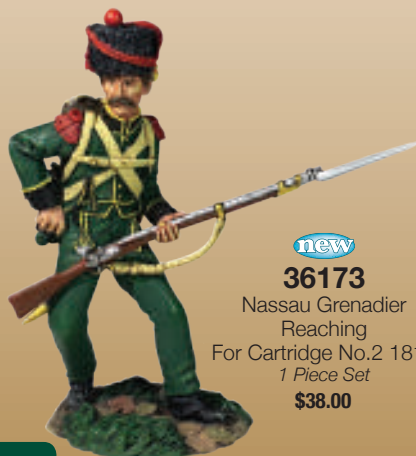

## Napoleonic

On Sunday, June 18, 1815, the Duke of Wellington recorded in his dispatches “at about ten o’clock [Napoleon] commenced a furious attack upon our post at Hougomont,” thus starting the fighting at Waterloo.

This brick and stone chateau became the epicenter of fighting on the allies’ right flank and Napoleon continued to direct attacks toward it all afternoon, 33 battalions in all.

Wellington sent the Light Companies of the 1st Foot Guards, the Coldstream Guards and the Scots Guards, to bolster the garrison there consisting of the 1st battalion, 2nd Nassau-Usingen Regiment and detachments of Jägers and Landwehr of the 1st Hanoverian Brigade.

These troops were told to hold the ground “at all costs” and successfully defended the chateau and farm against the onslaught of over 14,000 French infantry and the French bombardment that ruined the place.

“Certainly,” Wellington declared afterwards “the success of the battle turned upon the closing of the gates at Hougomont.”

Our newest additions to the Napoleonic range are Grenadiers of the 2nd Nassau-Usingen Regiment. Later in the year will be additional figures, including their colours, drums and officers.



The Black Brunswickers (Schwarze Legion) were raised in 1809 to oppose Napoleon Bonaparte's occupation of Germany. Most of the men in this unit wore black wool uniforms giving them the nickname of the "Black Horde." The Lieb Battalion was even more imposing wearing large silver death's head insignia on the fronts of their shakos, which were topped by tall black horsehair plumes.

The Black Brunswickers earned themselves a fearsome reputation over the following decade of combat, taking part in several important battles, including the fighting at Quatre Bras on the 16th of June 1815.

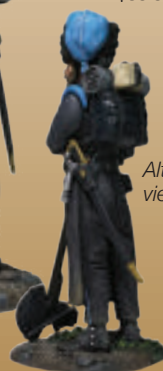

# MUSEUM COLLECTION

The Museum collection continues to expand with new and exciting additions.

Pershing, Kitchener and Kaiser Wilhelm II are three military leaders from the great and terrible conflict, World War I.

After many years of requests we have returned to the Alamo with the opposing leaders at the legendary siege in March of 1836. Although the attire of William B. Travis is based on scant evidence, the uniform of Antonio Lopez de Santa Anna is not only well documented by period portraits, but by surviving items of dress.

We also have a new exclusive figure representing one of the most important Native American leaders of the early nineteenth century, Tecumseh.

Finally, we are re-energizing and re-visiting old subjects with new improved sculpts, chief among them Alexander Hamilton and Thomas Jefferson.

W.Britain hopes that you history buffs enjoy this diverse line of notable personalities as much as we do.

The 26th President of the United States was an author, cowboy, statesman, explorer, adventurer, environmentalist, reformer, Governor, peacemaker, soldier and visionary. One of the four great statuarys on Mount Rushmore, Theodore Roosevelt is a larger than life character and celebrated personality.

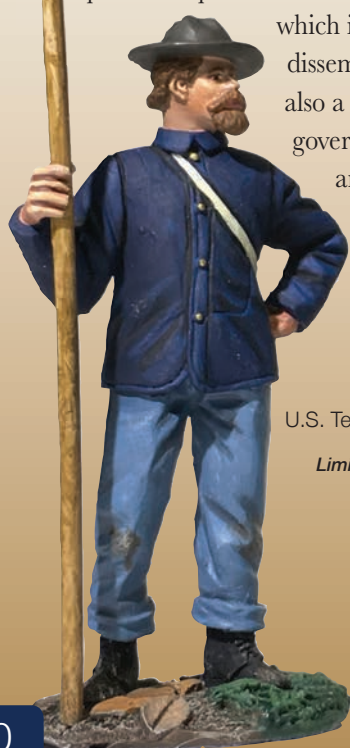




## AMERICAN CIVIL WAR

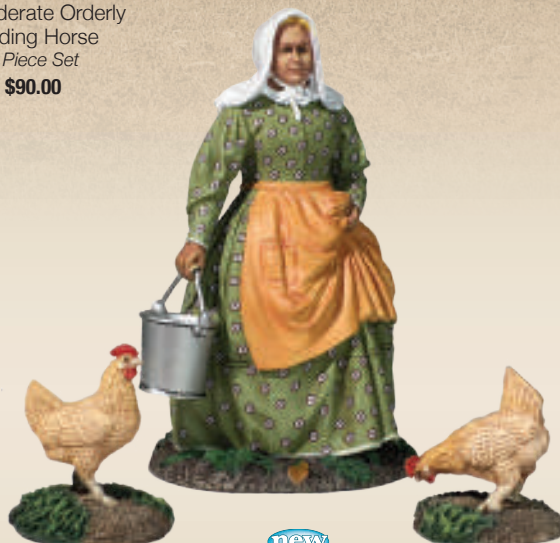

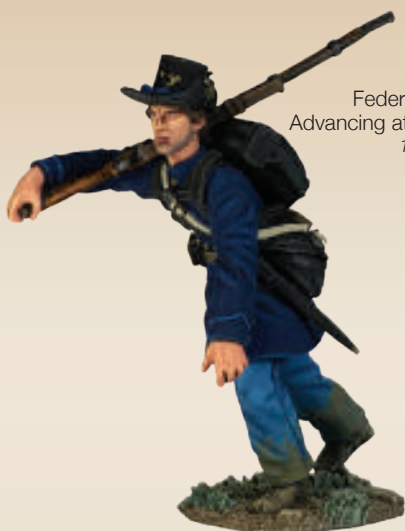

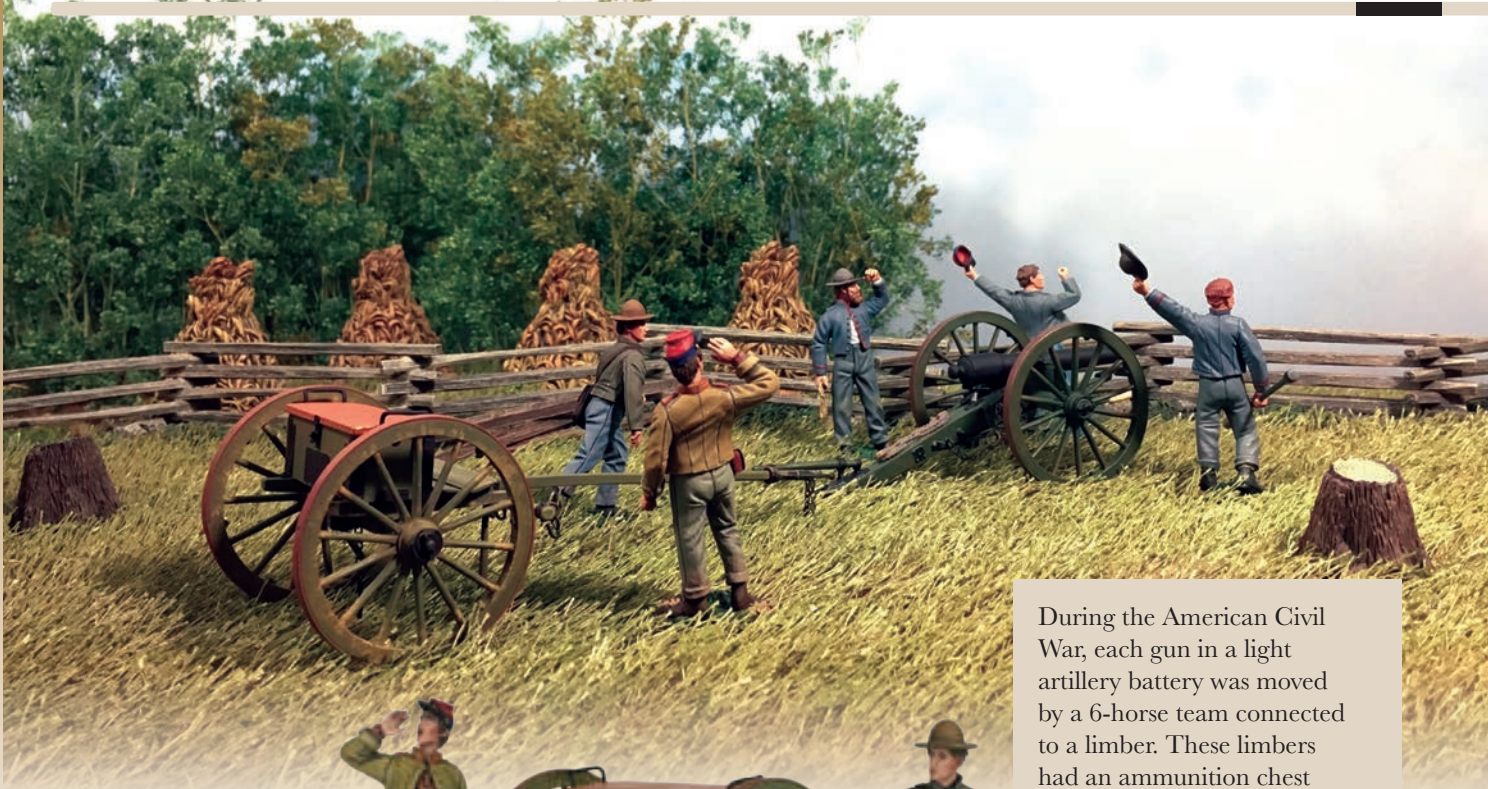

During the American Civil War, each gun in a light artillery battery was moved by a 6-horse team connected to a limber. These limbers had an ammunition chest that doubled as a seat for members of the crew when on the move. This wooden chest contained ammunition, friction primers and the tools needed to set fuses, clear vents, and if needed, spike the guns. The leather belts and fuse boxes for the crew were also carried in the tray in the chest.

The same pattern limber was used for all of the field artillery guns in service during the war on both sides. Our new artillery limber is accurately modeled from scale drawings prepared from surviving examples and is the first of several sets to be released this year.

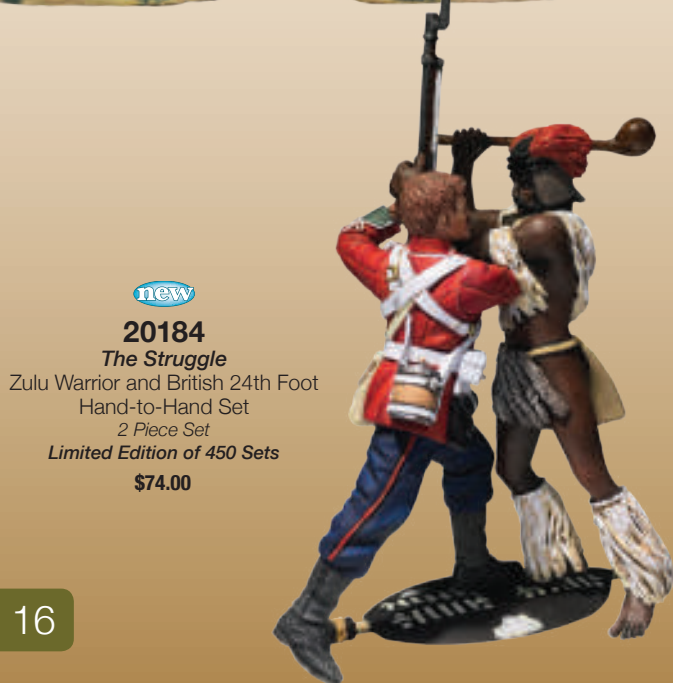

# War Along the Nile

Our War Along the Nile series continues with the Battle of Tel-el-Kebir.

The Egyptian army, led by Ahmed Urabi, rebelled in 1882, discontented with Egypt and its close ties to British and French financiers.

The United Kingdom reacted to protect its financial interests in the country, in particular the Suez Canal, and sent a force of 24,000 British and 7,000 Indian troops to quell the revolt.

The main Egyptian force dug in at Tel-el-Kebir, north of Cairo. The defenses were hastily prepared, but included trenches and redoubts

and studded with 60 pieces of artillery.

Rather than making an outflanking movement around Urabi's entrenchments, the British staged a night attack, relying on the element of surprise to secure the field.

W.Britain captures the savage, close-quarter fighting of this desperate engagement with an offering of 18 dramatic, new figures.

# World War I

While not the most effective, gas was certainly the cruellest weapon of World War One. A machine gun could saw you in half, an artillery shell, vaporize you in an instant, but gas...

Depending on which agent was deployed, gas would leave a soldier weeping and wheezing; blind and helpless; make his skin to blister and burn; cause a build-up of fluid in his lungs, ultimately drowning him.

Gas was heavier than air and would fill the trenches, dugouts and shell holes where it had been known to lurk for two or three days. It would permeate to a soldier's clothing and cling to his equipment. Many of those who suffered exposure were unable to return to the front. Those who did recover were at higher risk of developing cancers later in life.

While gas accounted for less than 1% of the total deaths in WWI, by the end of the conflict, one in four of the artillery shells fired on the Western Front contained gas.

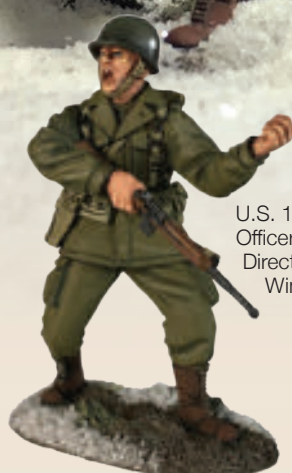

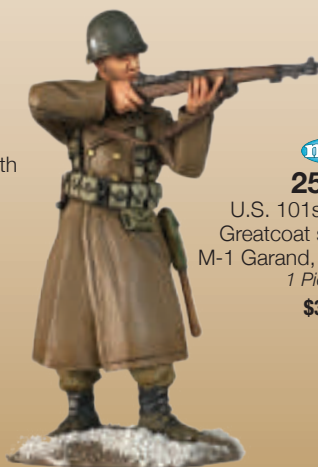

## WWII

On the 16th of December, Germany launched a major offensive in the heavily wooded area of the Ardennes and managed to make deep penetrations into the U.S. defenses in that sector. The surprise attack caught the Allied forces completely off guard as the action developed into the largest and bloodiest battle fought by the United States in World War II.

By January 25th of 1945, the 'Bulge' in the allied lines had been completely reduced, severely depleting Germany's armored forces on the Western Front, crippling their ability to resist the final Allied push to the Rhine.

Our newest World War II releases focus on this time period and will be developed in depth to allow the collector to represent any of the engagements in the closing days of war in Europe on the western front.

The 8.8cm Flak gun was possibly one of the most recognized German weapons of World War Two. The gun was developed between the two world wars, and to avoid the restrictions put in place by the Allies on Germany's military, the first model was given the designation of Flak 18, the year the war ended. The Flak designation stood for Flugabwehrkanone, meaning aircraft defense weapon.

With Adolf Hitler's ascent to power, the newer models of weapons were given dates based on the year of introduction with models of 1936 and 1937 to

follow with improvements on the model 1918.

Although designed as an anti-aircraft gun, the single piece barrel of the new gun was set on a complex mounting that allowed the gun to be used either at aerial or ground targets. The versatile carriage allowed the 88 to be fired in a limited anti-tank mode while still mounted on the wheels and its crew could emplace it in as little as two-and-a-half minutes.

Our new model represents a Flak 36 with the improved two-piece barrel for easier replacement of worn liners and an armored shield to provide some protection for the gunners.

This model also introduced the new heavier dual wheeled carriage

that allowed it to be fired with limited traverse and elevation while still mounted on the wheels and without its outriggers.

The 88 fired three main types of ammunition:

High-explosive (Sprenggranate, Sprgr.) shells with spring-wound or inertia-operated time fuze (up to 30 seconds) for air targets.

High-explosive shells with percussion fuze (impact or 0.11 second delay) for use against fixed targets or ground troops.

Armor-piercing (Panzergranate, Pzgr.) shells with tracer and small base-fuzed bursting charge for use against tanks.

## The GOOD SOLDIER

Shortly after the start of the War of 1812, Congress authorized the establishment of the 2nd and 3rd Regiments of U.S. Artillery.
