PAINTED FIGURES

INTRODUCTION

Since 1976 we have been producing toy-style figures for the collector. These are created and moulded in our studio by our designers, to the consistent scale and standard that our customers have come to expect.

Our 54mm figures are made of various mixtures of lead with tin and antimony, according to which is most suitable for each particular piece. Maximum detail is achieved with the use of a centrifugal casting machine.

The next step in the process is to remove the "flash" (the excess metal which forms at the mould parting line) to give a clean outline.

Castings are then assembled and hand-painted in traditional gloss colours, for a better-than-traditional toy-style finish. Sets are then boxed in leatherette-covered boxes, the figures being protected by foam or bubble-wrap.

INTRODUCTION

Since 1976 we have been producing toy-style figures for the collector. These are created and moulded in our studio by our designers, to the consistent scale and standard that our customers have come to expect. Our 54mm figures are made of various mixtures of lead with tin and antimony, according to which is most suitable for each particular piece. Maximum detail is achieved with the use of a centrifugal casting machine.

The next step in the process is to remove the "flash" (the excess metal which forms at the mould parting line) to give a clean outline.

Castings are then assembled and hand-painted in traditional gloss colours, for a better-than-traditional toy-style finish. We can also offer an acrylic/matt finish if requested. Sets are then boxed, the figures being protected by foam or bubble-wrap.
