TM No. 5 Tewhatewha

This figure represents a chieftain wielding a tewhatewha (two handed club). He wears a dogskin cloak of alternating colours over another cloak with decorative border, and upon his face, buttocks and thighs is moko (tattoo).



TM No. 6 Pepe

We present a mother carrying her pepe (baby) upon her back, and under her cloak, whilst carrying a basket, an image often captured in early photography and paintings.



TM No. 7 Haka

A chieftain performing a haka, a war dance of defiance well known within the New Zealand culture. He is armed with a taiaha and wears a cloak of bird feathers. Upon his face, buttocks and thighs is moko (tattoo).



TM No. 8 Waiata poi

This figure portrays a young woman performing waiata poi, action songs where the motions of balls suspended on cords accompanied the song. She wears a bright cloak of bird feathers.

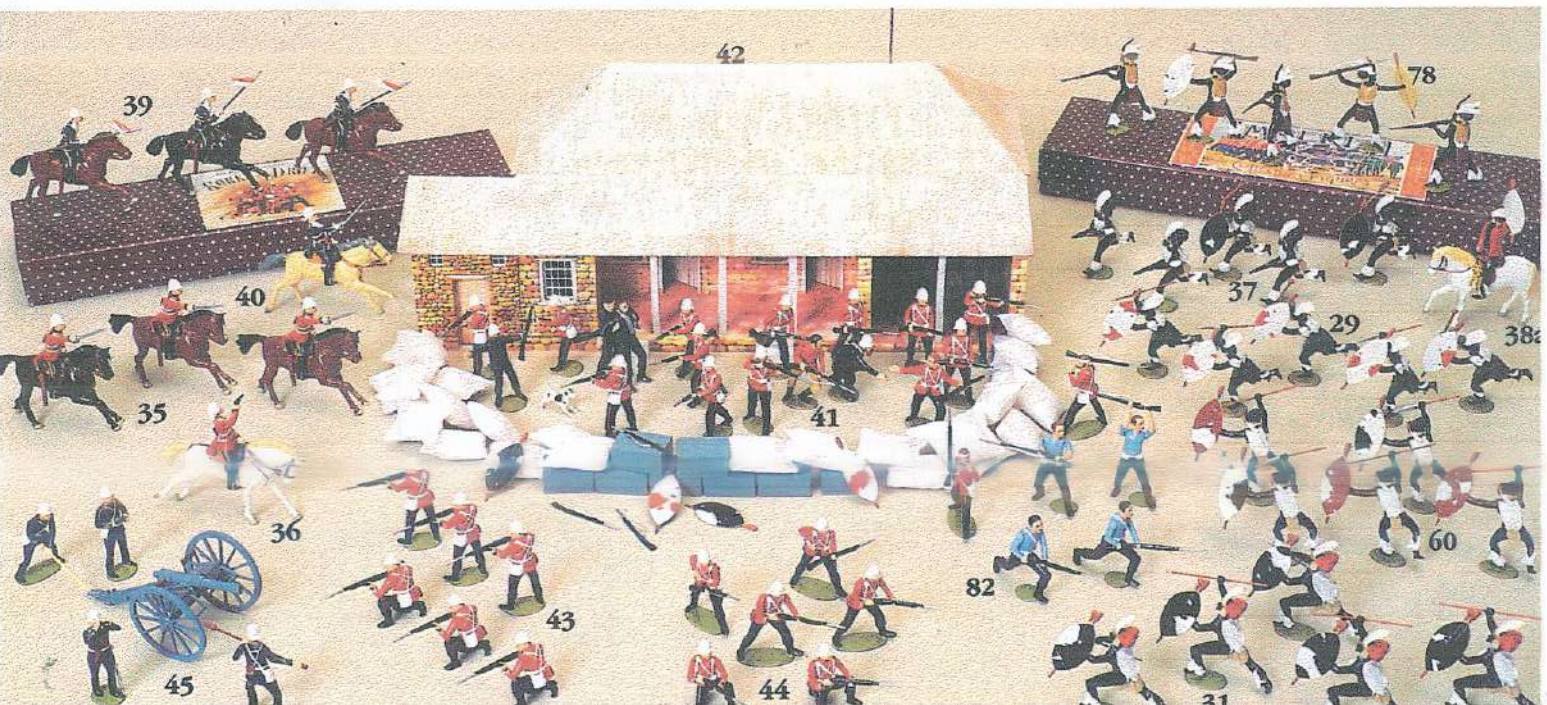

ZULU WAR 1879

In January 1879 a British army marched into Zululand. At Isandlwana a large portion of this army was outflanked by the traditional Zulu attack and suffered a disaster. Then at Rorke's Drift mission station, a small garrison held off attacks by about 4,000 warriors for several hours, earning for the defenders eleven Victoria Crosses. Finally at the Battle of Ulundi, a wall of British infantry and artillery broke the spirit of the Zulu nation. 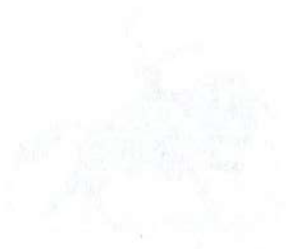


Fig. 1. *Salix glauca* L. var. *glauca* L.

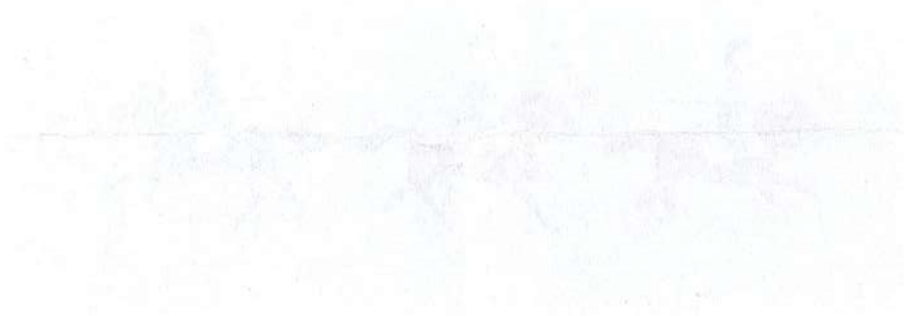


Fig. 3. *Salix glauca* L. var. *glauca* L.

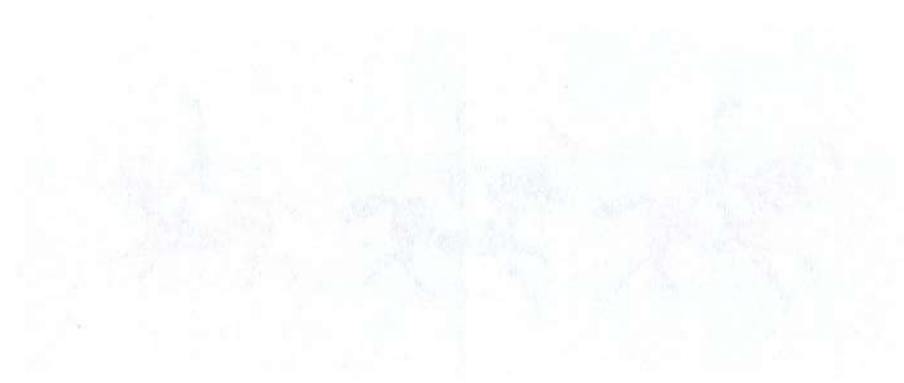


Fig. 4. *Salix glauca* L. var. *glauca* L.
