

Postal Money Orders and British Postal Orders should be payable at Plumstead, Herbert Road, Post Office, London, SE18 3ST.

When quoting a debit or credit balance, please give the invoice number on which this is shown.

Direct mail orders of ANY amount under £10 carry a packing and postage charge. This has to cover bookwork as well as the actual packing materials and postage. This bookwork is the same for an order of 50p or £50! To save this, support your local dealer - addresses listed on other pages.

All orders, except for painted models, are sent by return.

Overseas orders go by seamail unless air postage is requested and paid for. Painted models are all done to order and in strict rotation so the length of delay depends on the amount of work already in hand.


With our multiple castings ANY part cast separately may be ordered separately. We have shown on the A, B and C Lists a selection of parts: use these as price guides.

When ordering mounted models please state your choice of horse. There are:- 102, 103, 2, 4, 5, 6 and 7. Horses 2, 4 and 6 can have heads in three positions - neck stretched, neck arched or head down. For these and also for 102 and 103 there is a choice of tails, docked, short, long or bushy. Horses 5 and 7 have thicker terrained bases and can only be supplied with these, but with interchangeable heads and tails.

Please note that this is a MAIL ORDER business. Personal callers can only be seen by Prior Appointment.

#### ABOUT ROSE MINIATURES

The models are east in an alloy with a high tin content. This means that apart from the sharper castings with good definition, the models are stronger than those made from lead, and also they are not susceptible to the lead disease which manifests itself by peeling paint and a powdery white oxide showing through cracks in the paint.

The multiplece models can be assembled using any suitable adhesive, we use and recommend Araldite. Impact adhesive is not suitable as the pushing of pegs into holes is a sliding motion not an impact one. Before applying adhesive, clean off any flash line or easting marks, usually a light run round with a penknife is sufficient. Then the parts can be given a light rub with wire wool sold for cleaning saucepans, (not the wool with soap added). When using Araldite a little warmth will speed drying. A light bulb in a biscuit tin will act as a very efficient oven for this. If the arm pegs are loose in their holes, cut a cross in the end with a penknife, this will cause the end to swell enough to give a tight fit until the Araldite hardens, 20 minutes in a warm oven.

A cost of white paint will give a good ground for painting and will allow the colours to show their full value.

Two colours which trouble many beginners are flesh colour and khaki. To make flesh colour mix white, yellow ochre and scarlet to about the colour of your hand. It will look rather doll like. Now add a touch of light green and this will make it flesh colour. Khaki varies a lot from a pale yellowish colour to a darkish green. Yellow ochre mixed with black will give a good starting base.

Our card gives instructions for the Company Colour of the 1st Company of the 1st Battalion Coldstreams. To make a Sergeant on normal parade, order BGR 2 with the right arm with S.L.R. from BGR 1 (see Spring Supplement), and paint on his stripes.

#### NOTES ON THE GERMAN TROOPS OVERLEAF

The Oath taking ceremony for SS recruits was conducted by Junior Officers such as Hauptsturmfuhrers. The regulation number of recruits sworn in at one time was three or five; in the case of three, two men stood on one side of the sword and one on the other side. The "Old Fighters" chevron shown on the rightupper arm was awarded to those who were members of the SS or NSDAP or other Party Organisations before 1933.


