## Rose Miniatures . . . How it began

On leaving the Royal Navy after the war in 1946, I studied Art at Goldsmith's College London University. Towards the end of my time there I entered an open competition to design and construct the design figures and displays for the "Cotswold Tradition Exhibition" due to be held at Cirencester as part of the Festival of Britain Exhibition in 1951. I completed this and the Press gave it a very good write up.

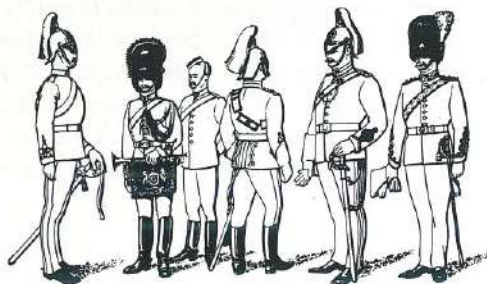
I then started up as an Industrial Artist expecting clients to flock to my door. I received a few commissions but not enough to keep a roof over my head. I was then asked to make some small figures 2¼" high of all the colourful personages who would be attending the Coronation of H.M. the Queen in June 1953. I completed about 20 models for this, but after a year with this firm I started up as a free lance Industrial Artist again. I then taught Art part time, And slowly started to get more work. I also received many letters from people who had bought coronation models and now wanted military models.

When not doing other work I designed and cast military models on our kitchen gas stove. I joined the British Model Soldier Society and produced a simple price list. Steadily the customers increased and I bought a centrifugal casting machine. Through my exhibition work I was elected to be a Member of the Society of Industrial Artists which later became the Chartered Society of Designers.

The business was growing, and Mary, my wife, had taken on the office side of the business and was training young women. I was employing trainees to help make the masters and othes to do the casting. We moved to larger premises and soon we were producing printed catalogues, casting machines working and a press to make our own moulds. The business had by now spread world wide and when the Military Modeller started we had half page adverts in it. The next thing was to buy our own colour printing press, guillotine, and a I.B.M. typewriter. We could now be completely self sufficient and have things printed in days of instead of weeks.

Unfortunately when I was ready to retire I could not find anyone ready to carry on the business. Now however, Mr. Jim Robinson is getting Rose Miniatures going again, and I wish him well in this endeavour.
